- ◆ GET INVOLVED in promoting appropriate public policies and volunteering for efforts they believe in.

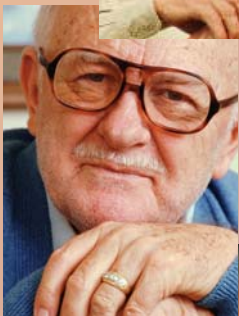
